If your child is beyond the age of one and yet to see a Newcastle dentist, there's no need to be ashamed.

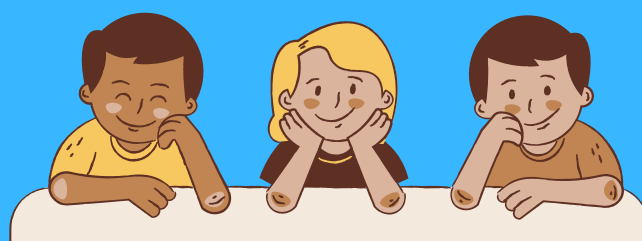


Visit a family/children's dental clinic
